Under LP Digital, we also coordinate a coalition of organizations working around women's digital inclusion in Tanzania, from which Tanzania Women and Technology stems. The coalition has been working together on digital skills capacity-building programs and advocacy programs around the elimination of online gender-based violence to address the digital gender divide.

WOMEN AND TECHNOLOGY CONFERENCE 2023 REPORT IN SUMMARY

The first Tanzania Women and Technology conference, organized by LP Digital, aimed to promote women's leadership and participation in technology. The event, themed "DigitALL: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality," took place on March 7, 2023, at the Julius Nyerere International Convention Center.

The conference began with a welcome address from Carol Ndosu, co-founder of The Launchpad Tanzania, emphasizing the importance of women's participation in the dynamic tech sector and the need to close the gender gap in technology.

Keynote addresses from notable speakers included Mr. Nathan Beleke from the World Bank Group, who discussed the gender gap in internet access and efforts to close it, especially in Africa. Miss Tabitha Etutu from the Ministry of Education highlighted the government's initiatives to support science and technology, especially for women.

The guest of honor, Hon. Nape Moses Nnauye, the Minister of ICT in Tanzania, emphasized the conference's alignment with the government's goals and policies to empower women in the tech industry. He acknowledged the existing gender gap in technology and government initiatives to overcome it.

The conference recognized successful women in technology, including Janeth Henry Tilya, Raya Ahmada, Catherinerose Barreto, Agnes Mollel, Dr. Cecilia China, and Prof. Najat Mohamed, for their contributions to health tech, edutech, technology inclusion, fintech, agritech, and overall excellence in technology.

Representatives from COSTECH and the ICT Commission shared their perspectives on promoting science and technology, ensuring inclusivity, and addressing gender disparities. The conference featured a documentary highlighting the achievements, challenges, and opportunities for women in technology in Tanzania.



GSMA presented statistics on digital use in Tanzania, emphasizing the importance of gender-responsive policies to bridge the digital gender gap.

Lessons learned and future prospects for women in technology were discussed, emphasizing the need for women to embrace the tech-driven future and overcome gender-based obstacles.

SHETECH Incubator and acceleration program

The SheTech Incubator and Accelerator Program 2023, initiated and led by The Launchpad Tanzania's Women and Technology Project, is a groundbreaking women-focused initiative aimed at promoting gender equality and empowering women entrepreneurs in Tanzania's digital economy.

The program's core objectives encompass equipping women entrepreneurs with essential skills for developing, launching, and scaling digital solutions, fostering an ecosystem supporting women-led startups, and contributing to the promotion of gender equality within Tanzania's digital economy.

For the first cohort in 2023, the program facilitated 15 women who had tech solution ideas.
